Venue: Tournament will be played in one venue on 25 *Butterfly* green tables. In the training hall 8 tables are

available. Surrounds will be placed out (minimum) 10 x 5 m around each table.

Balls: Butterfly *** white

<u>Playing rules</u>: In accordance with the ITTF Laws and Regulations. All matches will be played best of five games, except the finals in men and women singles in best of seven games.

Limitations

Players are allowed to participate in maximum 2 events per day. On Saturday Boys/Girls 14 or Boys/Girls 16, who play their own classes, cannot play in Men's / Women's Teams.

System:

All the events shall be played in groups of 4 players (except the Team events).

Best 2 players of each group proceed to the finals where games are held in the knock-out system.

In Team events matches will be played according to the Corbillon Cup system, ITTF regulations 3.7.6.2.

(4 singles and 1 double). At least 2 team matches are guaranteed per participating team. Maximum 16 men and 16 women teams will be accepted. Mixed teams will also be accepted. If more than 16 teams are registered in each class, the teams with the highest sum in world ranking will be eligible to play.

All matches in Men Singles, Women Singles and Team events will count for the ITTF World Ranking.

Entries:

Each player's date of birth has to be stated in the entry form.

Please note that entries to Men's Singles, Women's Singles and Team events have to be submitted by your national table-tennis association.

Deadline for the preliminary entries: March 24, 2010

Deadline for returning the final entry form (please see the attachment): April 10, 2010

If more entries are received than can be accepted, those who have sent their preliminary entries by **March 24**, **2010** will be given priority.

Cancellations:

Please notify the organizers of cancellations for Men and Women Singles and Team events by April 10, 2010. Since April 11, 2010 all cancellations will be subject to penalty: Single's events EUR 20 and Team events EUR 40 per team.

Check the results:

All players have to check the game protocol right after the end of the match, to confirm it has been filled out correctly. The winner always has to sign the protocol to confirm.

Hotel / Hostel:

In order to apply for the special price, bookings must be made the latest **by March 24, 2010**. Number of rooms with tournament prices is limited. Please mark your accommodation preferences on the entry form.

Notice! In order to apply for the special tournament price, hotel and hostel reservations are to be done directly to the organizer, NOT to the hotel/hostel!

Hotel / hostel cancellations have to be submitted to the organizer by April 10, 2010 the latest.

If accommodation cancellation is made in the period **April 11, 2010 - April 22, 2010**, penalty is applied in the value of one night payment.

If accommodation cancellation is made from **April 23, 2010 or no-show**, penalty is applied in the value of 100% payment.

Transport:

Free shuttle bus will be organized between tournament venue and Hotel Reval Olümpia two times per day. Distance from Hotel Reval Olümpia to tournament venue is about 8 km.

Transportation to and from the airport or railway station to the hotel / hostel can be arranged for a fixed price EUR 5 per person one way.
